Sebastiaan Bowier has **pedalled** his way to inthe record books by completing the fastest ever time in the World Human Powered Speed Challenge.

The Dutch cyclist broke the world's speed record for a bike as he rode across Battle Mountain road in the Nevada Desert. Setting off with a little help, he became the fastest ever cyclist in a human-powered vehicle travelling at 133.78 kilometres per hour (83 miles per hour).

"I pushed 200 watts halfway and then I started 350, 400 watts and 110 (kilometres) or so. At one and a half miles, I thought I would go 20 kilometres faster. So from there I went flat out and went sprinting."

Bowier's high-tech recumbent bike was designed by students from two Dutch universities.

Difficult words: **pedal** (move by working pedals of a bicycle), **flat out** (as fast as possible), **recumbent bike** (type of bicycle where you lie on your back).
